## **General Information**

The Show Office will be open Friday night from approximately 5-7 pm and again at 7:00 am Saturday morning. The Show will start at 9 am. The arena will be open for schooling Friday night from 5 pm to midnight, and again at 6:30 am to 8:30 am on Saturday morning.

The show will be held in the Wilson Arena at the Texas Tech Equestrian Center, 5712 CR 1500, Lubbock, TX 79407. Stalls are available on the property. At least one bag of shavings must be purchased with every stall. Contact Patsy in advance at 806-792-4682 to reserve your stalls and RV hookups.

The AQHA Rulebook will serve as guidelines for the show.

Following AQHA safety guidelines, all Over Fence Riders and all Youth English exhibitors must wear an ASTM/SEI-approved helmet. We strongly encourage all riders to wear a safety approved helmet at all times.

## **Registration Information**

Entry forms can be found online at the Texas Tech Equestrian Team Facebook page. Pre-entries are encouraged and receive a discount of \$5 off of the office fee. Pre-entries can be emailed to [tech\\_equestrian\\_show\\_series@outlook.com](mailto:tech_equestrian_show_series@outlook.com) by January 25, 2019. Day of show entries must be made in the Show Office. Class adds need to be made at least 2 classes out in the Show Office. Exhibitors or the representative must also notify the Announcer and Gate Attendant of their class adds.

The All-Day Fee only includes English Flat Classes, Hunter Hack, Halter & Showmanship and All Western Classes.

The Fences Flat Fee only includes Working Hunter & Equitation Over Fences classes from Cross Rails through 3.0 to 3.3'.

Youth is exhibitors 18 & Under by January 1, 2019

Non Pro is any non-professional exhibitor over the age of 18 as of January 1, 2019, and does not receive payment for

showing, training, lessons for money.

Open is for any rider or trainer.

**Show Awards**

Ribbons for 1<sup>st</sup> through 6<sup>th</sup> place

High Point Award categories are: Youth English, Non Pro English, Open English, Fences, Youth Western, Non Pro Western, & Open Western

All Around Circuit Awards categories: Youth All Around, Non Pro All Around, Open All Around. To qualify for the All Around, exhibitor must compete in at least 1 English class, 1 Western Class, and 1 Halter or Showmanship class with the same horse/exhibitor combo.

For Jackpot Classes, Sit-A-Buck, & Egg and Spoon, bring \$5 to the gate for the class jackpot. Winner takes the Jackpot when they exit the gate.
